MSU Department of Art Undergraduate Exhibition Opens At Kresge Art Museum

E. LANSING, MICH.-- Excitement, ingenuity, and variety can all be found within Kresge Art Museum during the *MSU Department of Art & Art History 2004 Undergraduate Exhibition*, opening April 17. For the first look at this showcase of student work, join the Department of Art & Art History and many of the artists for the opening reception on Friday, April 16 from 7-9 p.m., which is free and open for all to attend. The *Undergraduate Exhibition* is an annual collaboration between the MSU Department of Art & Art History and Kresge Art Museum. This exhibition is sponsored by the Student Book Store.

The exhibition will be juried by Anna Greidanus Probes, Professor of Art at Calvin College who earned her MFA at Michigan State University. It will feature works of art created by undergraduate students at MSU in ceramics, drawing, graphic design, painting, photography, sculpture, and printmaking courses. Various types of traditional and electronic media will be represented. Awards, sponsored by the Student Book Store, will be given for Best In Show, first through third place, and other recognition awards.

“By displaying art at Kresge Art Museum by current undergraduates we offer the community an opportunity to see their accomplishments and for the students to be recognized publicly for their work,” says Director, Susan J. Bandes. “This annual exhibition is eagerly anticipated by students, faculty, families and the community.”

Kresge Art Museum is located in East Lansing, Mich. on the campus of Michigan State University. Its entrance is on Auditorium Road just west of the Alumni Chapel, on the first floor of the Kresge Art Center. Admission is free. The museum is open Monday through Friday, 10 a.m. to 5 p.m., Thursday until 8 p.m., and Saturday and Sunday, noon to 5 p.m. The museum is fully accessible to persons with disabilities.
